## Introduction Questions

## Understanding the Text Questions

- From this passage, where does life come from?
- What might the 12 kinds of fruit symbolize?
- Verse 5 says, "And they will reign for ever and ever." Who?
- What does this passage teach us about God?

**Also Read:** Genesis 2:8–10

- What similarities do you see in these two passages?
- Where was God in relationship to the people (At the beginning and at the end)?

## Application Questions

- How do we work on making this vision of the end a reality in our life now?
  - What needs to be different so that it looks more like this picture of the end?
- This is the last chapter of the Bible. How does the story end?
  - What's the point of the story?
  - What's the flow of the story?
- As you think back through this year, are there any stories that stand out to you?
